The Bow South Expedition is a charity kayak paddle down the entire lower Colorado River. This year's expedition is held as a fundraiser for Break The Silence Against Domestic Violence. Our team begins at Diamond Creek in the Grand Canyon and paddle 460 miles south through 3 wildlife refuges, 3 giant lakes, portage 7 dams, and end our journey where the Colorado River abruptly ends at Morelos Dam on the U.S. / Mexico Border.

This expedition is entirely self-funded by our team members. All money that is donated from individuals, groups, or businesses are made directly to the benefiting charity via our fundraising webpage.
